Royal Hall – Rural Schools Charity Concert 24th March 2023:

We are delighted to inform you that on Friday 24th March a choir of pupils from the Federation of Beckwithshaw, Kettlesing and Ripley Endowed CE Primary School have the fantastic opportunity to join with twelve other local rural primary schools in a concert at the Royal Hall in aid of the Harrogate Hospital and Community Charity, and the Sir Robert Ogden Macmillan Centre.

Our choir is open to children in Classes 3 and 4. The choir will be performing three songs and will then join the other schools to perform a further two songs for a grand finale.

Children will be transported to the event via coach for an afternoon of rehearsals and will remain at the Royal Hall until the concert commences.
